UAS4EUROPE conference held in Brussels on 15 March 2017

The EURASHE-led UAS4EUROPE network for UAS applied research organised its first conference on 15 March 2017 in Brussels titled 'Maximising Success in Horizon 2020 and Beyond – Learn! Network! Lobby!' which was followed by a high-level reception. It brought together more than 200 researchers, policymakers and rectors from 29 European countries. In addition to the conference the network has also published a statement on the mid-term evaluation of the Horizon 2020 and the upcoming FP9.
