


Higher Education in Serbia

- **◆ 18** accredited universities **8** state and **10** private universities
- Serbian universities on prestigious Shanghai ranking
- **187** faculties and **67** colleges of applied studies
- Around 250,000 students in total

Quality Assurance in Higher Education

- ❖ National Commission for Accreditation and Quality Control is a member of ENQA (from 2013) and EQAR (from 2014)
- **❖ 1553** study programs and **205** HEIs accredited up to 2011
- ❖ 1842 study programs and 261 HEIs accredited up to 2017
- ❖ External quality assurance in 160 HEIs 154 positive reports



Goals of National Strategy for Education Development by 2020, higher education

- ❖ 95% of those who completed secondary school to be enrolled in higher education
- ❖ 70% of those enrolled complete their higher education
- Participation of higher education 38.5%
- ❖ About 50% of students who complete bachelor academic studies continue their education with master academic studies

- Introduction of short-cycle and part-time studies
- Strenghtening the cooperation with economy with Council of Employers
- New category of teaching staff top business experts
