

The BPF concept until now

A logics of EHEA openess and competitiveness

- Providing adequate information and promoting better the EHEA (Louvain, Vienna)
- Attracting more international students and staff (all)
- Developing a EHEA internationalisation strategy in line with the UE internationalisation strategy, with a strong focus on mobility (Bucharest)

With tentative of regional dialogues

- Bucharest : ASEM and recognition conventions (Lisbon and Tokyo)
- Yerevan: MENAAS countries bordering the EHEA



BPF organisation

- Preparation (4 WG, organisation or participation to events, reports (EHEA and national non EHEA -See Vienna)
- A specific programme parallel to the European Ministerial conference
- A worldwide participation except for Yerevan (see Secretariat document)
