The German Rectors' Conference, the German Academic Exchange Service and the Stifterverband für die Deutsche Wissenschaft are organising an international conference on "New Perspectives of Legal Education in Europe". We cordially invite you to this meeting which will take place in the Deutsche Bank Forum in Berlin on 18 - 19 March 2010.

Whether or how to change legal education is subject to intensive and controversial debate on the way to a common European Higher Education Area. Together with academic experts and students we will discuss the state of the art of legal education in Europe.

The conference is an occasion to rethink legal education and how to prepare lawyers – i.e. legal experts and practitioners – for the future. It is an opportunity to critically review state guidelines and legal curricula, to introduce new teaching and learning formats, and to strengthen competencies in research.


We will provide you with more detailed information after you have registered for the conference.
